Report 7:

2016-2017 Budget Update

P. Smithers provided highlights current 2016-2017 Budget. This included a 2 % rough increase on the expense side of the budget made mostly of salary obligations, renewed transportation contracts, and capital monies that could not be run through the capital fund. M. Tooley commented that at this time this is the best look at the budget the district has had in years. There is also some additional aid expected in the coming months to help with the shortfall in the budget of \$257,274. The administration has also been asked to look at some of the areas of the budget where exact amounts can be determined to see if what is currently in the budget can be made more exact and those monies could be moved to areas where it would provide more cushion. L. Mitchell asked about the current status of back taxes and P. Smithers will be taking on this task to ensure that the school is provided with what is owed. Mr. Vernsey discussed a new item that has been worked into the budget for 2016-2017, Capital Outlay. This is an aid program supplied

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by the state when a school meets certain requirements for a job within \$100,000 the state will return 98% of that cost to the school district the following year.
