Dear Board Members:

On Tuesday, August 9, 2016, bids were received for Phase 6 of the Capital Improvements Project at Ogdensburg Free Academy. This work includes the site lighting and temperature control upgrades; as well as the interior lighting replacement at the Golden Dome under the Capital Outlay Project. A total of (9) bids were received for the two prime contracts. A bid tabulation sheet enumerating the bids received is attached.

The following summary will address several key issues for the Board's consideration as you deliberate to contract award and construction:

I. Review of Apparent Low Bid

II. Review of Alternates

Within the (2) contracts, alternates were included as a critical part of the overall bid strategy to give the District flexibility at the time of contract award. The alternates and their associated cost as identified by the apparent low bidders are as follows:

Contract No. 1 - Mechanical

Alternate No. 1 (Temperature Control Upgrade at CUHs)	\$ 26,000	ADD
Contract No. 2 – Electrical		
Alternate No. 1 (Aluminum Light Pole Covers)	\$ 16,800	ADD
Alternate No. 2 (LED High Bay Efficiency Luminaires)	\$ 29,980	ADD

Based upon the Total Base Bids received, it appears that the District is in a position to consider selecting one of the above Add Alternates. It would be our recommendation to accept the Alternate No. 2 for the upgrade of interior light fixtures to LED at the Golden Dome. While the initial cost is more expensive than the base bid T5 high output fluorescent fixtures, the expense can be recouped over time through greater energy efficiency. The LED technology has a longer lifespan, low driving voltage, and fast response time.



III. Review of Overall Phase 6 Budget

In anticipation of the Board of Education's action to accept the Apparent Low Bidders and Add Alternate for LED Light Fixtures at the Golden Dome, we have prepared the following draft overall budget:
