
FACTS AND ANALYSIS:

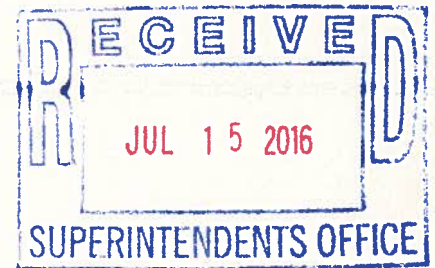

At a regular Board of Education meeting held at 7:00 p.m. on June 9, 2016, the Lisbon Board of Education approved a resolution to petition the Ogdensburg City School District Board of Education to allow Lisbon Central School boys to participate in interscholastic boys' lacrosse at the modified level for the 2016-2017 season.

The merger resolution was moved by Blake Gendebien, seconded by Nancy Addison, and carried with six (6) yes votes and one (1) absent (Davison).

If this petition is approved, then all participating Lisbon Central School athletes will be required to abide by all Lisbon Central School academic eligibility rules and all rules and regulations covered in the student handbook for Lisbon Central School students.

We anticipate that the Ogdensburg City School District will support this merger that benefits our student athletes.

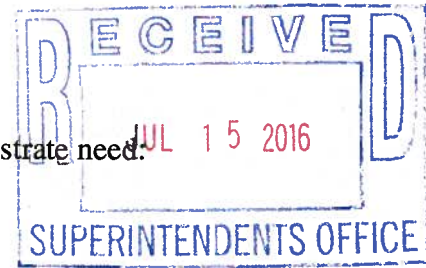




