Declaration of Emergency Pesticide Application Resolution

REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:

The Board of Education of the Ogdensburg City School District must authorize a "Declaration of Emergency Pesticide Application" in accordance with the "Safe Child Playing Fields Act".

FACTS AND ANALYSIS:

Whereas, Education Law Section 409-k indicates the necessity for the Board of Education to declare a health emergency prior to any application of pesticides on playing fields (weed over growth is creating slippery athletic field conditions) and;

Whereas, the presence of weed populations have been identified on the baseball fields at Ogdensburg Free Academy; therefore

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Moved by _____ and supported by _____ that, having the approval of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education of the Ogdensburg City School District does hereby approve the emergency application of pesticides to remedy this situation that presents a health hazard to students and staff in these locations. The Board hereby directs the District's School Pesticide Representative to provide proper notifications prior to any applications.
