SUBJECT: First Review of Revised Board of Education Policy # 7421 Sports
and the Athletic Program: Sports Mergers

DATE: September 19, 2016

REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:

The Board of Education must review and approve all policies and regulations of the Ogdensburg City School District.

FACTS AND ANALYSIS:

The Board of Education must establish criteria for sports merger requests from other school districts to allow out-of-district students to play on OFA athletic teams. Mr. Carl Norman, Director of Interscholastic Athletics, Section 10, has made several suggestions to add information to the district's current Board of Education Policy # 7421: Sports and the Athletic Program: Sports Mergers. The suggestions are included in red on the current policy.

SUBJECT: SPORTS AND THE ATHLETIC PROGRAM: SPORTS MERGERS

1. School administration shall not forward a request from another school district for a sports merger unless the following criteria are met:
 - a. The coach, Athletic Director and Superintendent of Schools support the request.
 - b. There shall be no additional cost to the Ogdensburg City School District for participation of students in another school district seeking to participate on an OFA sports team.
 - c. No OFA student trying out for the team shall be prohibited from playing on the team. However, if a merger is approved the coach reserves the right to move an OFA student to a team at a lower level for which the student is eligible if they believe the student's skill level warrants such a move. **(Not sure if you need it as the NYSPHSSA handbook permits it already)**
 - d. Playing time will still continue to be at the coach's professional discretion, based upon the skill level of the athlete. **(Playing time will continue to be a non-negotiable item and will be determined at the coach's professional discretion, based upon their own team rules in conjunction with the Ogdensburg City School District Code of Conduct).**
2. The Board of Education maintains the right to deny a request for a sports merger even if the criteria listed above are met.
3. The Board of Education reserves the right to restrict participation in a sports merger to students in another school district who have participated in the past at OFA in the sport for which a merger is requested. Every effort will be made to allow a student from another school district who has played a sport at OFA to continue as a team member in that sport if they are in good standing and if their home school makes the request for a sports merger.
Note: the criteria listed above in #1 & #3 must be utilized in the decision making process.
4. The Board of Education reserves the right to assess a fee to a school district whose students play on an OFA athletic team. **This will be based on the OFA billing formula for "merger students".**
