Dear Board Members:

On Tuesday, August 18, 2020, bids were received for the 2020 Capital Outlay Project involving pool equipment room upgrades at Ogdensburg Free Academy. A total of (4) four bids were received for the single prime contract. A bid tabulation sheet enumerating the bids received is attached.

The following summary will address several key issues for the Board's consideration as you deliberate to contract award and construction:

I. Review of Apparent Low Bid

Contract No. 1 - Mechanical

II. Review of Alternates

Within the contract, an alternate was included as a critical part of the overall bid strategy to give the District flexibility at the time of contract award. The alternate and associated cost as identified by the apparent low bidder is as follows:

Alternate No. 1 Pool Filters \$ 14,550 ADD

Based upon the Total Base Bid received, the District is in a position to consider accepting the above Add Alternate and replace the (4) existing pool sand filters.



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III. Review of Overall Budget

In anticipation of the Board of Education's action to accept the Apparent Low Bidder and Add Alternate, we have prepared the following draft overall budget:

BID DESCRIPTION

CONTRACT NO. 1 - MECHANICAL

Work under this Contract may generally be described to include, but not be limited to the following:

All selective building demolition; minor demolition for remodeling, removal and disposal of existing building systems and components as scheduled or required for the execution of the work.

All temporary signage; temporary barriers; construction staging; concrete; metals; rough carpentry; firestopping; joint sealers; plumbing (swimming pool plumbing systems); HVAC (firestopping; identification; testing, adjusting & balancing; duct insulation; piping & equipment insulation; commissioning; direct digital control system; hydronic piping; ductwork; fans; breechings, chimneys, and stacks; finned water-tube boilers; terminal heat transfer units); electrical (firestopping; low-voltage electrical power conductors & cables, grounding & bonding; hangers & supports; boxes; conduit; panelboards; equipment wiring); and all other work and related materials as detailed in the Contract Drawings, as described in the Contract Specifications, and as needed for a complete and proper project.

This outline is a general indication of the requirements of this Contract and is not intended to be all inclusive. The complete Contract Documents in their entirety, to include any and all addenda, form the basis of the responsibility of this Contract.

Each contractor is advised that the specification sections in <u>Division 1 - General Requirements</u> apply distinctly to each Prime Contractor and the balance of the technical specifications apply to each Contractor (as appropriate) for the accomplishment of his work.

All work of this contract shall be coordinated with other Prime Contractors involved in the project. All work shall additionally be coordinated with all other activities, construction, or others at each site throughout the progress of the work of this project.

The Mechanical Contractor shall use all means possible and shall be responsible for coordinating the installation of all materials of this Contract with work of all other trades involved with this project. All work shall be done in strict accordance with the Contract Documents and in compliance with all applicable Local, State and Federal Codes.

Prior to the Bid Date of this project, the Contractor shall be completely responsible for visiting the project site to become completely familiar with the scope of this project.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and the respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation or recommendation of any bid.

It shall be completely understood that the use of asbestos containing materials in this project is strictly forbidden and all materials are provided in accordance with the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), and the New York State Asbestos Safety Act (SASA).

In addition to those items in the Base Bid, the Mechanical Contractor shall further sub-divide his bid proposal as described in the following bid items, alternates, and/or unit prices. The Mechanical Contractor shall include in the Base Bid all of the work of this Contract not specifically described in a Bid Item or Alternative. The Owner reserves the right to accept any and/or all of the Bid Items and/or Alternates or any combination thereof and to waive any informalities or defects in the bid proposals either before or after opening.

CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT

As a result of the Iran Divestment Act of 2012 (the "Act"), Chapter 1 of the 2012 Laws of New York, a new provision has been added to State Finance Law (SFL) § 165-a and New York General Municipal Law § 103-g, both effective Aprils 12, 2012. Under the Act, the Commissioner of the Office of General Services (OGS) will be developing a list of "persons" who are engaged in "investment activities in Iran" (both are defined terms in the law) (the "Prohibited Entities List"). Pursuant to SFL § 165-a(3)(b), the initial list is expected to be issued no later than 120 days after the Act's effective date at which time it will be posted on the OGS website.

By submitting a bid in response to this solicitation or by assuming the responsibility of a Contract awarded hereunder, each Bidder/Contractor, any person signing on behalf of any Bidder/Contractor and any assignee or subcontractor and, in the case of a joint bid, each party thereto, certifies, under penalty of perjury, that once the Prohibited Entities List is posted on the OGS website, that to the best of its knowledge and belief, that each Bidder/Contractor and any subcontractor or assignee is not identified on the Prohibited Entities List created pursuant to SFL § 165-a(3)(b).

Additionally, Bidder/Contractor is advised that once the Prohibited Entities List is posted on the OGS Website, any Bidder/Contractor seeking to renew or extend a Contract or assume the responsibility of a Contract awarded in response to this solicitation must certify at the time the Contract is renewed, extended or assigned that it is not included on the Prohibited Entities List.

During the term of the Contract, should the School District receive information that a Bidder/Contractor is in violation of the above-referenced certification, the School District will offer the person or entity an opportunity to respond.
