# Report 12:

2021-2022 Budget Update

P. Smithers listed the large ticket items in next year's budget. Salary and benefit increases are the majority (\$700,000 – \$350,000 in special education as we have brought back some classrooms). There is a \$200,000 increase in equipment. We held off on spending money for equipment last year and used it towards the security project, which we get reimbursed for almost 100%. We will get about \$285,000 to match the line item.

Transportation costs also increased due to contract expirations that were up this year.

L. Mitchell commended all involved for an incredible job. To present a budget that brings in 12 buses with only a 2.13 increase in the tax levy is extraordinary.

E. Testani Asked some questions about staffing during COVID and the impact on the budget. There is a risk that state aid will not be as high as anticipated and this could negatively affect the budget. She also inquired about savings in sports. Is that being reappropriated? P. Smither's responded unfortunately we cannot ear mark dollars. The district has to add left over money to the fund balance and this is monitored by the state.

The Board discussed the proposed Capital Outlay Mini Project to replace the Boiler at OFA.

C. Lalonde inquired about an increase in BOCES administrative budget. P. Smither's explained BOCES tells us the administrative line is mostly the retirees and that would be mostly the health insurance cost.
