Enclosed please find NCE Environmental Consultants November 22, 2020 Fire Inspection Report for all the buildings in the district.

Please note all deficiencies noted in the report have been addressed/corrected. As a result of Mr. Warneck's report a subsequent comprehensive inspection was ordered and performed by NCC Systems Inc. in December 2020 for all three schools pertaining to our kitchen facilities ansul, fire detection, fire notification and rolling door systems. Multiple deficiencies were found in all three schools and have been corrected or replaced with new code compliant systems. To date I believe we are in full compliance at all facilities.
