On June 27th, bids were received for the 2023 Capital Outlay Project involving parking lot reconstruction, sidewalk replacement and domestic water heater upgrades at OFA. A total of thirteen (13) bids were received for the four (4) prime contracts. A bid tabulation sheet enumerating the bids received is attached.

The following summary has been provided for the Board's consideration as you deliberate to contract award and construction:
