SUBJECT: Approving the Reconfiguration of Grade Levels Among Buildings

DATE: March 30, 2026

REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:

WHEREAS, the Ogdensburg City School District is undertaking a reorganization and consolidation of its elementary school programs to better align resources and instructional services with current student needs; and

WHEREAS, the District has experienced a significant decline in student enrollment over time, necessitating a review and adjustment of its existing grade configurations and building utilization; and

WHEREAS, the District has historically assigned students to elementary schools based primarily on their residential address within the District; and

WHEREAS, each elementary school building has traditionally served students across a full grade span, including Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) through Grade 6; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Ogdensburg City School District hereby approves the reorganization and consolidation of its elementary school programs such that John F. Kennedy Intermediate School shall be reconfigured to serve students in Grades 2 through 6, and Dr. Grant C. Madill Primary School shall be reconfigured to serve students in Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) through Grade 1; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent of Schools is authorized and directed to implement the necessary steps to effectuate this reorganization, including but not limited to the reconfiguration of grade levels, school naming, and student assignments, consistent with applicable laws, regulations, and approvals from the New York State Education Department.
