Ogdensburg City SD Energy Performance Contract

Ogdensburg City Central School District is embarking on energy conservation improvements that will dramatically increase efficiency and save money. The district's energy savings performance contract with Day Automation Systems, Inc. calls for:

- LED lighting to be installed throughout, including the replacement of lighting at the Ogdensburg Free Academy Turf Complex
- Building automation system (BAS) upgrade
- Building envelope improvements in all district buildings

The work will be fully funded over the 18-year contract period by savings in energy and associated costs. Between the state aid generated and the savings realized by these improvements, *there is no impact on the local tax levy.* The estimated net savings from energy utility reduction is \$3.5 million over 18 years or 29%.

The initiative is not subject to voter approval, but a positive vote from the community would increase state aid for the project by 10% (approximately an additional \$555,000 in state building aid). The district will also qualify for an estimated \$105.000 in incentives from NYSERDA.

The target date for starting the work is June 2026.

Benefits of the Energy Performance Contract



Carbon Footprint Reduction: Potential for 49% reduction or 1066 tons of CO² emissions. That's the equivalent of what it takes to provide electricity to 19 homes in a year.



LED Lighting: LED lighting products produce light about 90% more efficiently that incandescent light bulbs. Better lighting benefits student instruction.



Greater Energy Efficiency: Greater efficiency in energy usage and temperature control by upgrading the building control management system and reducing infiltration into the building with insulation and other measures.



Project Pays for Itself: The energy performance contract is self-funding over 18 years.



Savings Guarantee: Day Automation projects an annual savings of up to \$280,000 for the district and will make up the difference in the event of a shortfall.



Additional State Funding; The project leverages our community's tax dollars to improve the campus and student's future by gaining 10% in state funding with a positive vote.



Education and Enrichment: Day Automation will provide educational and enrichment opportunities for students and teachers.
