By-Laws

SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT AND DUTIES OF THE CLAIMS AUDITOR

The Board may adopt a resolution establishing the appointment of an claims auditor who shall hold the position subject to the pleasure of the Board and report <u>directly to the Board</u>. No person shall be eligible for appointment to the office of claims auditor who shall be:

- a) A member of the Board;
- b) The Clerk or Treasurer of the Board;
- c) The official of the District responsible for business management;
- d) The Purchasing Agent;
- e) Clerical personnel directly involved in accounting and purchasing functions.

The Claims Auditor is <u>not</u> required to be a resident of the District and shall be classified in the civil service exempt class.

The Board may delegate this claim audit function by using inter-municipal cooperative agreements, shared services through a Board of Cooperative Educational Services, or independent contractors.

Valid claims against the District shall be paid by the Treasurer only upon the approval of the Claims Auditor. The Claims Auditor shall:

- a) Substantiate expenditures;
- b) Meet such other requirements as may be established by the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education and/or the Comptroller of the State of New York.
